The Barataria-Terrebonne National Estuary Program (BTNEP), [www.btnep.org](http://www.btnep.org), and Calliope Puppets, <http://www.calliopepuppets.net/>, are proud to announce the performance tour schedule of “**The Fisherman and His Wife**”, from the Brothers Grimm “Greed”, set in the wetlands of South Louisiana.

First toured three months before the devastation of Hurricane Katrina, Calliope Puppets offers a theater piece for family audiences focused on the critical impact of coastal wetlands loss. Education on this issue is crucial not only to the people of the fragile Gulf Coast area, but to the entire country, as human and natural resources are affected, nation wide. Written and built in the winter/spring 2005 by artistic director, Karen Konnerth in collaboration with Deborah Schultz, former Formal Education Coordinator of the Barataria-Terrebonne National Estuary Program, based in Thibodaux, LA.

Through dynamic hand and rod puppets, colorful scenery, live music and sound effects, and lots of singing and thoughtful assistance from the audience, Calliope Puppets adapts this familiar Brothers Grimm tale to a setting in the wetlands of south Louisiana.

This tale of the wife who asks too much of the magical fish her husband catches features classic characters and imaginative adaptation to promote understanding of the effects human decisions have on several wetlands residents.

All performances are **free** to the public.
